

Application for library card for children and young persons

The card is personal and no one else is allowed to use it for borrowing from the library. If you lose your library card, please contact us so we can block it from use. Keep in mind that as a guardian, you

- are responsible for everything your child borrows on their card.
- consent to the child's personal data consisting of name, social security number, address, telephone number and email address, and that the guardian's/your contact information are recorded in our library data system.

We also record the child's loans and reservations, as well as the return date. Loan details are deleted upon return. If a book is destroyed or not returned, the parent/guardian must pay the costs of replacing the lost item. Each municipality has its own procedures for school loans and other loans during school hours.

The terms of loan will change when the child reaches the age of 18. At that time, the person will have to accept the loan rules and sign their new library card for adults.

The personal data is used to enable your child to borrow, reserve books and book times to use library computers. The personal data is handled at all public libraries in Norrbotten: Arjeplog, Arvidsjaur, Boden, Gällivare, Haparanda, Jokkmokk, Kalix, Kiruna, Luleå, Pajala, Piteå, Älvsbyn, Övertorneå and Övertorneå.
